Welcome to the 5th annual Summer Art Explorations camp! This year we are delighted to offer not only adventures in the visual arts, but in the dramatic and musical arts as well. Funds generated from the camp will go towards The Greyhound Foundation's goals for the Arts, and will support local educators' implementation of innovative programs that enrich our youth. Open to 3rd through 8th grade students and held in the art wing of Shippensburg Area Senior High School, camps run from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday June 5 through Thursday June 8. Students should bring a packed lunch to eat during a one-hour lunch and outdoor play time. Tuition is \$150 with all supplies provided. Each class is limited to just 16 students, so sign up soon to secure your spot! The deadline for registration is May 5th.

Course Offerings

Make It Move: Introduction To Stop Motion Animation

Current and future YouTubers UNITE! The basic concepts and techniques of stop motion animation will be explored and campers will create their own stop motion videos in this fun and informative workshop. Everyday objects will come to life using these fun and easy-to-learn techniques. Bring your own imagination, all other equipment supplied!

Scary Glumps & Silly Creatures

Students will explore a variety of 2D media including drawing, painting, ink, and collage. Campers will be challenged to develop a series of imaginative creatures based on famous literature, yet emanating completely from their imaginations. Fun & creativity will abound in this exciting course melding the animal kingdom, mystical monsters, and science fiction with fundamental and progressive artistic methods and materials.

Six Strings: Intro to Guitar

Campers will explore the basics of playing an acoustic guitar, learning to read guitar chord tablatures and developing

their ability to play chord progressions, leading to their ability to perform a 12 bar blues chord progression. Music elements including rhythm, steady beat, time signatures, melody contour and chord progressions will be explored in a relaxed and fun atmosphere. Students will create and share simple chord progressions with their peers. Guitar is supplied, please do not bring your own.

Treasure Trove

This course will provide students with the opportunity to try their hand at jewelry making. A variety of methods and techniques for wire work, bead making, metal etching, resin casting, and more will be explored. At the end of the course, each student will have created several unique and finished jewelry pieces to take home.
